Attention: 1506-0001, Revised Suspicious Activity Report by Depository Institutions.

To whom it may concern:

I don't really have any comments concerning the proposed enhancements to the SAR-DI, other than I am curious as to when a financial institution might ever file a SAR jointly with another financial institution, as indicated by the new check box "1b". I do not find an explanation for this in the instructions. However, the main reason for this comment letter is to dispute your estimated time for completing a SAR. If I am reading your proposal correctly, you state that it takes just 60 minutes per form. I wish this were true! When you consider the time it takes to gather all of the facts in each case, I would estimate it takes me an average of 6 hours per form. You need to reconsider your burden estimate. Thank you.
